Pioneers Burnt Out At Bezanson

BEZANSON (Correspondent)
— Fire ripped through the home of a Bezanson district pioneer couple yesterday.

The single-storey home of Mr. and Mrs. George Ames was completely destroyed by the blaze believed to have been caused by faulty wiring.

Mr. Ames said he spotted smoke pouring from the attic of the building a few minutes after going to his son's house 100 yards away.

The house was completely engulfed by flames when Grande Prairie county fire department answered the call.

The Ames were able to save only a few personal effects. Their farm is about one-quarter mile west of here.

Long time residents of this district, Mr. and Mrs. Ames came to Bezanson in 1916. Mr. Ames has been in poor health for some time.
